Respect for Umpires Please Sadly, there has been a further altercation (but not physical violence) involving an umpiring decision. A playing member has been banned for one game following a passing comment of an unsavoury kind made by this none-striking batsman to the umpire. The receiving batsman was given out LBW by a neutral umpire with a second neutral umpire standing at square leg. In line with the recommendations of the square leg umpire, the Management Committee have voted to impose a one match ban and the player concerned has been informed and warned as to his future conduct. In line with the ECB directive, the name of the banned player will not be generally announced, but those teams involved will be informed. The player's name will be given to Ian Wardle for the ECB and directly to the Northumberland League for their information. There are further issues here which will be followed up by the Management Committee.
